Building/Facility Committee – This committee oversees the building and school grounds, as well as assist with school safety and security.

Curriculum Committee – This committee reviews all changes to curriculum and coordinates recommendations made by faculty and staff.

Finance Committee – This committee is responsible for the financial oversight of the school's budget and expenses.

School Accountability Committee (SAC) – This committee is responsible for making recommendations concerning priorities for spending school funds, making recommendations concerning the preparation of the school's Performance, Improvement, Priority Improvement or Turnaround plan (whichever is applicable). The SAC meets at least quarterly to discuss implementation of the school's plan and other progress and is also responsible for cooperatively determining, with the local school board, the areas and issues, in addition to budget issues, that the SAC shall study and make recommendations upon.

Monument Academy Foundation – While not a committee of the Board, the Foundation is under the leadership of its Board of Directors and is a non-profit corporation separate from MA and its Board of Directors. The primary purpose of the foundation is to oversee the management of endowments and participate in the allocation of the funds it raises on behalf of Monument Academy.
