High School Only Note: Students who transfer to a different high school without a bone fide family move over the summer will have restricted eligibility for the first 50% of the season in the upcoming school year in those sports (sponsored by the CHSAA) in which they participated during the calendar year preceding the transfer.
School of Choice approval in the Lewis-Palmer School District is valid for the duration of the academic level (elementary, middle, or high school). Subsequent Choice Enrollment applications are required only when the student transitions to the next academic level and wishes to attend a school other than the neighborhood school.
Before considering requests from non-resident students, priority shall be given to in-district students.
Approval is based on class sizes and other District 38 considerations. The District reserves the right to rescind and/or amend choice enrollments in future years if, in its opinion, overcrowding or other undesirable conditions develop as provided in District 38 policies JFBA and JFBB and regulations.
