#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE:**

The start of the cold and flu season is upon us. To prevent widespread flu in the school, we recommend that your child stay home from school if experiencing flu or cold symptoms. To decide whether or not to send your child to school, please consider the following guidelines.

Consider keeping your child at home for an extra day of rest and observation if he or she has any of the following symptoms:

Very stuffy or runny nose and/or a cough

Mild sore throat (no fever, no known exposure to strep)

Headache

Mild stomach ache

Definitely keep your child at home for treatment and observation if he or she has any of these symptoms:

Fever (greater than 100 degrees. Your child may return only after temp has been consistently

below 100 degrees, by mouth, for a minimum of 24 hours)

Vomiting (even once)

Diarrhea

Chills

General malaise or feelings of fatigue, discomfort, weakness or muscle aches

Frequent congested (wet) or croupy cough

Lots of nasal congestion with frequent blowing of nose

To help prevent the flu and other colds, teach your children good hygiene habits:

Wash hands frequently

Do not touch eyes, nose or mouth

Cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, use a paper tissue, throw it away and then wash hands

Avoid close contact with people who are sick

The El Paso County Public health department recommends adults and children receive the seasonal flu vaccine. Be assured it is not too late to receive a flu shot. The flu shot is one of the best ways to prevent illness from the seasonal influenza virus.
