- Please consider sending your child/children to school with a significant snack; although lunch will occur as normal, it's a long day for the students!

### \*\* IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARENTS OF 7TH GRADE STUDENTS:

- All 7th grade students will attend school normally on Wednesday, 4/8/20.

- 7th grade students who participate in the CMAS Social Studies assessment will complete this portion of the assessment in the library over the course of a normal school day.

- 7th grade students whose parents have refused testing will attend classes normally.

- 7th grade will be participating in the *Ponderosa* field trip on Friday, 4/10/20.

### \*\* IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS <u>NOT</u> IN GRADES 4, 5 or 8:

- Please note that students in grade levels <u>other than</u> 4, 5, or 8 do <u>NOT</u> participate in the CMAS Science/Social Studies assessments on Friday, 4/10.

- All students NOT in grades 4, 5 or 8 WILL ATTEND SCHOOL NORMALLY on this day.

## IMPORTANT NOTE FOR ALL PARENTS WHO HAVE REFUSED TESTING:

For parents who have exercised their legal right to refuse state standardized assessments for their children in grades 3 through 8, please reference the CMAS/PARCC Assessment Schedule above.

To help us facilitate completion of standardized assessments as efficiently as possible, we ask that parents refusing state standardized assessments allow their **non-testing children to remain home from school for the entirety of their grade level's scheduled assessment days with the exception of 7th grade on Wednesday, 4/8/20** (this request does not apply to scheduled makeup days).
