From Mr. R. & Ms. Barrette: We hope you all had a wonderful, relaxing Thanksgiving break.

An important safety reminder as we plan on returning to a daily MA routine next week:

Our School Resource Officer has observed parents driving through the parking lot after student drop-off with unrestrained young children passengers. We have been informed that this is a *Class 3 Misdemeanor* and could result in Department of Human Services involvement and court appearances, in addition to traffic tickets and fines. In the interest of safety for the entire community, please ensure **all** passengers in moving vehicles are properly restrained at **all** times.

At Home COVID-19 Symptom Screening Tool for Parents and Staff

Parents and guardians can use these symptom checklists to determine when to keep their child at home. School staff can also use this tool to determine if they need to stay at home. **Any student or staff diagnosed with COVID-19 or who is a close contact of a COVID-19 case should not go to school and should [isolate or quarantine](#) according to public health recommendations regardless of current symptoms.**

This symptom screen refers only to new symptoms or a change in usual symptoms. A student/staff should not be kept home for usual symptoms they experience due to a chronic condition unless they are worse than usual. These guidelines are in addition to your regular school guidance (for example, a child with vomiting should also not attend school based on usual school guidance). Please refer to the [Return to Learn](#) guidance to determine when it is appropriate to return to school.

If your child or you are experiencing any potentially life-threatening symptoms, please call 911.

Symptom Screen:

If any of the following symptoms are present, keep the child at home/stay at home, inform the school of symptoms, and reach out to a health care provider about COVID-19 testing and next steps for treatment.

- Feeling feverish, having chills, or temperature 100.4°F or higher.
- New or unexplained persistent cough.
- Shortness of breath.
- Difficulty breathing.
- Loss of taste or smell.
- Fatigue.
- Muscle aches.
- Headache.
- Sore throat.
- Nausea or vomiting.
- Diarrhea.
- Runny nose or congestion.

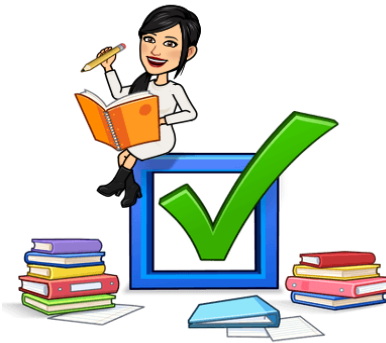

Mrs. Collier is MA's *Battle of the Books* representative and acts as liaison between schools and the T-shirt committee. She can only submit four designs to the committee.

All designs must adhere to the following requirements:

- Submitted designs must be original illustrations and include artist's signature and '2020.'**
- Design MUST be in Black Ink. Pencil drawings do not scan well. Please consider simple, bold designs to those with many lines and shadows.**
- Submissions must contain all 40 book titles:**

- Artists can use the book titles directly in their design or listed underneath the design.
- Design must include something to recognize the unique year of the *Virtual Battle* (the April and May competitions will be virtual, not in-person.)
- Design must be submitted in a digital format in *Adobe Illustrator/Photoshop* or other compatible software saved to a *.eps, *.png, or *.pdf file.
- Digital design must be a transparency, i.e. when printed, T-shirt color comes through any background where no design exists (the negative space of the design).
- Designs must be submitted no later than **January 15, 2021** for final judging. *Send your design and information to Mrs. Collier before the January 15th deadline. Good luck!*

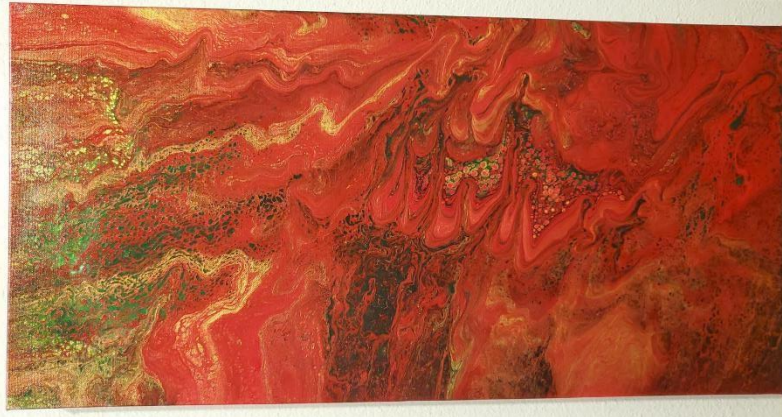

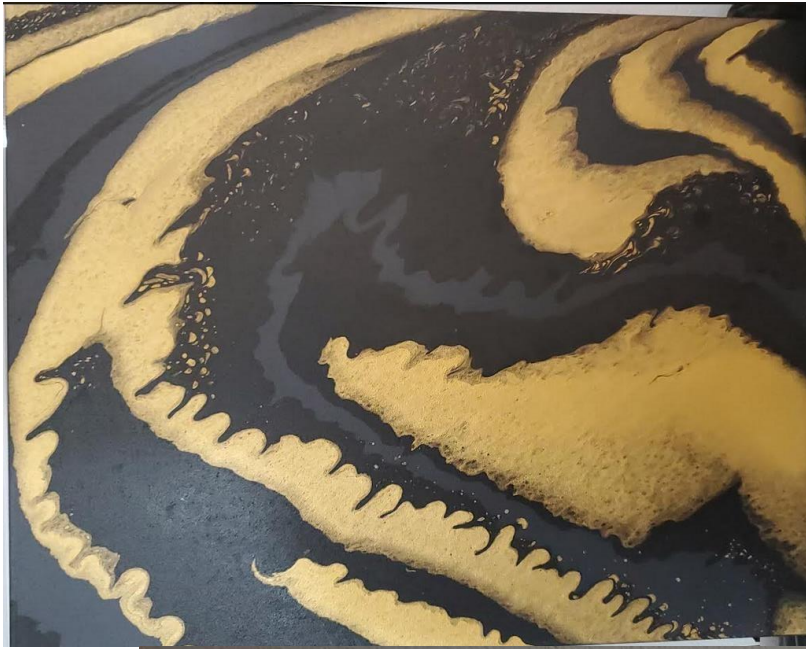
