2021 Colorado State Standardized Assessments

<u>HB 21-1161</u> was passed by the Colorado House and Colorado Senate and then signed by Governor Polis on the evening of 3/16/21. For more information, please see the latest <u>Chalkbeat article about HB 21-1161</u>. At this point <u>HB 21-1161</u> goes to the U.S. Department of Education for consideration. Until they weigh in, we must proceed with the understanding that all CMAS testing is required.

If, after reviewing <u>HB 21-1161</u>, the U.S. Department of Education grants a waiver, CMAS Science & Social Studies would be suspended, Math would be administered to students in grades 3, 5, and 7, and ELA will be administered to students in grades 4, 6, and 8. This plan does not affect PSAT offerings for our high school students. This plan would allow parents of students in grade levels not being assessed in ELA or Math to opt-INTO those assessments, and if approved a future communication will be sent outlining the procedure for ensuring your child/children may complete those assessments. This puts us in a difficult position for finalizing assessment schedules with the assessment window fast approaching. We want to give our families as much lead time as possible, so we have crafted a schedule that should work regardless of the decision made by the U.S. Department of Education.

Here is a schedule for when state standardized assessments (CMAS/CoAlt - PSAT) will be administered at each of the Monument Academy campuses:

PLEASE have students, who are completing assessments, in school and on-time. Please avoid scheduling appointments on their scheduled assessment days. When the school has to "make-up" state standardized assessments for students who are late or must leave during the assessments we have no choice but to significantly interrupt their regular instructional time. Thank you.

2021 Colorado State Standardized Assessment Refusals

We expect that some families may choose to refuse allowing their students to complete CMAS/CoAlt assessments this year due to concerns about COVID-19. The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has asked us to include an option for specifying COVID-19 as a reason for refusal to our normal refusal process, and this refusal choice has been added to our standard refusal form. Monument Academy accepts online refusals only per *Board Policy 1525* found at the link below:


