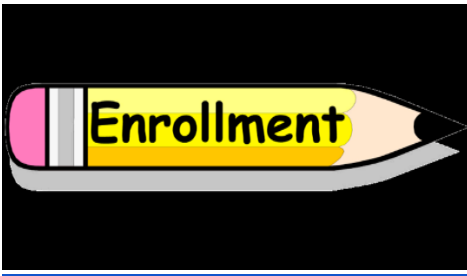
How to Raise a Reader
