Tuesday: twin day


Description/Ex: dress up with your best friend the exact same so you look like twins! Same hairdo, same clothes, same shoes, same everything!

2021 Colorado State Standardized Assessment Refusals

If you still plan to refuse allowing your students to participate in standardized assessments this spring, regardless of the reason, Monument Academy accepts online refusals only up until three days before the date of assessment per Monument Academy Board Policy #1525. An assessment refusal completed as described in the board policy above will allow Monument Academy to comply with CDE requirements and avoid negative consequences to our school. Please do not print out/submit any paper forms or e-mail us scanned documents. We expect that some families may choose to refuse allowing their students to complete CMAS/CoAlt assessments this year due to concerns about COVID-19. The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has asked us to include an option for specifying COVID-19 as a reason for refusal to our normal refusal process, and this refusal choice has been added to our standard refusal form.
