From D~38 Lunch Services

At the beginning of the school day, students need to order their lunch accurately so that there is enough food to serve all the students.

Under the current USDA lunch program, which is providing free lunch for all students this year, the portion sizes are the same for all grades. Students may ask for seconds of the entree and the cost is \$1.85 even if the student qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Due to COVID restrictions, the salad bar is located inside the kitchen, but students can request extra portions of fruits and vegetables from the lunchroom staff at no extra charge. Please review your child's lunchroom balance which can be found in Infinite Campus under the Food Service tab. Payments can be made at the front desk by check payable to LPHLP (Lewis Palmer Hot Lunch Program) or by using the MySchoolBucks app.
