At the beginning of the school day, students need to order their lunches accurately so there is enough food to serve everyone. Under the current USDA lunch program, which is providing free lunches to all students this year, the portion sizes are the same for all grades. Students may ask for seconds of the entree <u>at a cost of</u>

\$1.85, even if the student qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Due to COVID restrictions, the salad bar is located inside the kitchen, but students can request extra portions of fruits and vegetables from the lunchroom staff at no extra charge.
