PE WEEK OF FEB 14 SNAPSHOT...

Middle School

Middle School PE students are getting outdoors this week (Mon/Tue) to begin their soccer unit. In addition to launching soccer, students will continue to work on foundational strength movements (Triple Extension, Push, Pull, Hinge, Brace, Rotation, and Single Stance) that include Max Push (Up) Monday, Drop Squats (intro to plyometrics), Medicine Ball Catapults, Lateral Squats, Hand Plank Rotation, and Pullups. Wednesday & Friday = Free Play Days and they'll also be introduced to Soccer Tennis.

High School Team Sports & Conditioning

HS PE students, like MS, will be outdoors for team soccer and experience the same foundational strength movements as the MS students.



Additionally, HS Team Sports students will be introduced to Foam Rolling 101. Foam Rolling 101 is self-massage for tight muscles and ligaments and general well feeling. It's a bit of a love-hate relationship at first, but for those in the know, it's all love in the end!

HS Yoga / Strength & Conditioning

This week, HS students will continue sampling a variety of movement patterns and stress relief through instruction on good breathing, neck/shoulder relief, a day of soccer and Free Play Days on Wednesday and Friday. Let's move!


Objectives


How does this benefit the athletes?


