## MARCH: MEDICINE BALL MANIA!

March is here and we have two weeks until Spring Break. But first, our students will be introduced to Medicine Ball Mania!

Since the beginning of the semester students have been introduced to the basics of using a medicine ball for a variety of movements for building greater strength, learning how to pick up weight safely, and best of all, take a little aggression out when we SLAM, THROW, CATAPULT and in general, try to break the ball!

No one has ever regretted getting stronger, so we will be performing the following Medicine Ball movements in March:

- MB Front Squats (Brace/Triple Extension)
- MB Slams (Brace/Triple Extension/Pull)
- MB Rotational Throws (Brace, Rotation, Push)
- MB Wall Ball (Brace, Triple Extension, Push)
- MB Catapults (Brace, Triple Extension, Pull)
- MB Partner Passing (Brace, Rotation)
- MB Rotational Slams (Brace, Push, Pull)
- MB Sprints (Brace, Triple Extension, Push)

## WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE MOTIVATION VS DISCIPLINE

#### MOTIVATION

Motivation comes from the natural human drive to achieve something. Motivation doesn't last forever no matter how much you want something. It's a temporary effect created by the brain to boost you in the right direction.

#### 🕒 DISCIPLINE

Discipline is the ability to continue pushing in the right direction when you no longer have motivation doing it for you. Discipline is far more important than motivation and you should NEVER rely on motivation only.

It's getting to crunch time... end of Quarter 3 and the end of the year is just around the corner! We talk about the above poster that is posted in the gymnasium (permanently) on a regular basis. We believe it is such a simple but many times misunderstood idea....the difference between Motivation and Discipline. It is our hope that our students begin to appreciate the difference and understand that everyone goes through times they lack motivation and it is discipline that helps them get through those times.

• July 1 begin a 3-year term as a voting member of the MA Board of Directors
