Sam Inama set new school records in the 110m Hurdles (10.17) and the Long jump (18-10.0). Abigail Kuo set a new school record in the Discus Throw (63-09.0). The boys 4x800 also set a new school record with a time of 10:19.20.



MONUMENT ACADEMY AWARDED COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION GRANT

Monument Academy High School was recently approved to spend nearly \$75,000 of Colorado Charter School Program (CCSP) grant funds, to support the Physical Education Program! This grant will go directly to physical education, specifically strength & conditioning. The grant will support all high school students in their varied Physical Education classes as well as athletic teams. Equipment will include squat racks, barbells, kettlebells, maces, medicine balls, TRX suspension trainers, plyometric boxes, timers, and so much more! Pictured



to the right, is one of the pieces that will be installed in our future human performance center, the Rogue Monster Rig. This piece will give our students a nearly endless list of uses, from obstacle course challenges to squat racks and pull-up bars.

- 2.) Push
- 3.) Pull
- 4.) Brace
- 5.) Rotation
- 6.) Hinge
- 7.) Single Stance

Over the summer, continue to work on the fundamentals we focused on throughout the year, including front (medicine ball) squats, drop/forward/lateral lunges, pushups, pullups (climb anything you can!), single foot/leg balance, and many more!

COSMO will provide sticks to borrow, if you need one, or if you have one, bring it. No protective equipment is




