CMAS Information for Grades 6-8

If your child is in 6th - 8th grade, we are approaching that time of year when we administer the CMAS test (CO State Standardized Assessment). The CMAS testing window is from April 11, 2022, to April 29, 2022.

- 6th Grade testing (ELA and Math)
- 7th Grade testing (ELA and Math)
- 8th Grade testing (ELA, Math, and Science)

The specific schedule for CMAS testing will be published after spring break.

Throughout the school year, Monument Academy administers a variety of content related tests per state and federal requirements. This <u>assessment calendar</u> on the Monument Academy website provides details on each of the assessments (i.e., grades tested, purpose of test, dates of tests, format of tests).

Per Colorado law (HB 15-1323), parents have the right to refuse to have their child(ren) take the state standardized tests listed above. <u>Information regarding the process</u> for parent refusal is located on the MA website. The <u>refusal form</u> is located in FamilyID. All students, whether completing the assessments or not, will attend school at MA East on these days.

SoS is partnering with Project C.U.R.E. to gather donations to create Kits for Kids to send aid to Ukrainian kids! Thus, SUS (Supporting Ukrainian Students) was formed! Here is how you can be a part:

Students of SoS are asking the community from Monument Academy for donations to fill Kits for Kids. Items needed include:

- Acetaminophen (325 mg) OR Ibuprofen (Jr. or 200 mg.) **tablets** no liquid
- Box of Adhesive Bandages
- Triple Antibiotic Ointment
- 1% Hydrocortisone Cream
- Toothbrushes (min. 4)
- Hand sanitizer (travel size)
- Elastic Bandage
- Comb (6" or larger) ("rat tail" style not preferred)
- Facial Tissues (travel size)
- Blunt Scissors
- Tweezers
- Bar of Soap
- Nail Clippers (no manicure sets)

** Money is also accepted – checks can be payable to Project CURE.

New Athletics Programs



BACK TO THE BASICS AFTER BREAK!

We've all had a tough reentry to school after Spring Break. So this week we're returning to the basics, or movement fundamentals (see above pyramid), and getting everyone moving again. Monday, March 28 was like the walking dead around here, students and staff alike were not ready to go full speed or crush a fast paced day in PE. This week we're returning to fundamental movements like medicine ball front squats, pushups, handstands (Period 2 High School PE crushing them below), skipping, lateral movements and more.
