The Sustainability and Capacity Management goal reads:
Sustain Monument Academy's student enrollment and manage the related capacity issues to ensure top quality academic and individual development opportunities while providing its academic program in a collegial atmosphere of learning.

Monument Academy's capacity is determined by the Board's goal of 24 students per classroom in grades 1-5, 118 students per grade in grades 6-8 and 18 students per classroom for full-day and half-day kindergarten. Sustaining a consistent enrollment from year-to-year will enable Administration to manage capacity issues and maintain academic programs at a high level. (Board Policy 1523)
