

Mrs. Collier is MA's *Battle of the Books* representative and acts as liaison between schools and the T-shirt committee. She can only submit four designs to the committee.

All designs must adhere to the following requirements:

- Submitted designs must be original illustrations and include artist's signature and '2020.'
- Design **MUST** be in Black Ink. Pencil drawings do not scan well. Please consider simple, bold designs to those with many lines and shadows.
- Submissions must contain all 40 book titles:

- Artists can use the book titles directly in their design or listed underneath the design.
- Design must include something to recognize the unique year of the *Virtual Battle* (the April and May competitions will be virtual, not in-person.)
- Design must be submitted in a digital format in *Adobe Illustrator/ Photoshop* or other compatible software saved to a *.eps, *.png, or *.pdf file.
- Digital design must be a transparency, i.e., when printed, T-shirt color comes through any background where no design exists (the negative space of the design).
- Designs must be submitted no later than **January 15, 2021** for final judging. *Send your design and information to Mrs. Collier before the January 15th deadline. Good luck!*
