#### **Executive Director Update**

**Enrollment** - Enrollment numbers have shifted a little but Monument Academy is still up from the previous 22-23 school year overall. As of August  $10^{th}$  enrollment is as follows: Elementary (K-5) = 518 Middle School = 399 High School = 130

**Class Sizes** - Due to attrition that occurs before October count and to be fiscally responsible with our school budget for both schools we will oversubscribe classes by only 1 student per class based on the ratios and only if needed to allow students. To date no grade level is above the staff to student ratio set by the board of directors.

Free and Reduced Lunch - Monument Academy will be participating in the state's free lunch program for both campuses. There will be a fee for any additional items or extra drinks that students will want to purchase. However, families will still need to submit their Free and Reduced lunch documentation the same as in years past if you need assistance in other ways.
